Dr. Mojock called the meeting to order. He gave a brief overview of the details of the board meeting as follows:

**Board Topics**

The 2003-2008 Strategic Plan Analysis was presented. The Board was engaged and very complimentary of all the ways in which the college has made progress in the last five years. The 2008 – 2013 Strategic Plan is very ambitious and Dr. Mojock encouraged administrative council to read it. The current annual plan is published on our website.

The three year enrollment growth was shared with the Board. Each of the campuses has had increases.

The Annual financial report was discussed and LSCC is in good financial shape. Dr. Mojock complimented the work of John Froman and Sue Fagan.

The Constitutional Amendment #8 was discussed. There will be an effort to educate and make the public aware of the amendment.

**Senate Bill 1908**

There was discussion of the impact on rising seniors, comparing FCAT and CPT. The issues between AP and dual enrollment were also discussed. Dr. Mojock will pass along any information that is received from the legislative committees or the state college system.

**Supervisor Training**

Mr. Kane informed the Council that the pilot group involved in the training would finish up on October 3. The next session is October 17 – November 21. There will be open registration to get into the next session. The administrative council members who were in this pilot group spoke very favorably of the sessions.

## **Employee Development Quarterly**

Mr. Kane gave a brief overview of the training that will be available during the EDQ. Registration will be through LOIS. Dr. Mojock asked that supervisors work hard to coordinate the effort so that their employees could be involved.

## **Other items of information/reminders:**

There is an updated Visions and Mission statement that will be made available for all offices. Dr. Mojock asked that they be placed where they could be viewed by students, staff and visitors.
