Dr. Mojock called the meeting to order.

Dr. Mojock announced that he had met with MaP Forum and it was a good meeting to answer questions which had been sent in to Class Climate. He would like to do this on a regular basis and get more folks involved in a role of helping to respond to the questions asked. The meeting was taped and he encouraged all supervisors to watch it; there were several questions about supervisors and their role. Some of the other questions asked by MaP were also discussed. Enrollment is up significantly in Leesburg. The issue of what was driving this enrollment increase was discussed and several ideas mentioned.

Council of President and the Division are working to develop a new branding for the Florida College System. Dr. Sligh mentioned that FACC is waiting to see what the COP decides.

Dr. Mojock informed the Council that the Board had held a workshop about the New Vision for LSCC. The Board has a very open attitude of the concept and will be evaluating the process. Administrative Council will have an opportunity to be involved and give your opinion.
