## Declaration of F-1 Student Responsibility for Compliance with U.S. Immigration Regulations

Individuals who enter the United States on an F-1 student visa are subject to special requirements during their stay. Each individual is responsible for maintaining his or her F-1 status. Failure to maintain your F-1 status can result in immediate deportation and banned from entering the United States in the future. Please carefully read the following information about maintaining your status and sign below.

- I understand that I must enroll as a full time student during the first semester of attendance (12 hours) and every fall and spring semester of my program of study. I further understand that at least 9 credit hours in every fall and spring semester must be lecture classes (not online). I understand that if I am awaiting acceptance to a limited access program, I must continue to enroll in 12 credit hours during my first semester of attendance and each fall and spring semester thereafter.
- I must apply for an extension of my program of study prior to the expiration date on my I-20 from if I cannot complete my program by that date. As an F-1 student. I must complete and submit the form “recommendation for extension of program”. I must submit my request for extension between 30 and 60 days prior to the expiration date of my I-20.
- I must maintain adequate medical insurance coverage for illness and injuries in the United States.
- I will not change programs of study without approval from the International Student Advisor. I must also report any change of address or residence and/or change of name. I must obtain a new form I-20 before changing my name and/or academic program from one major/field of study to another.
- I must maintain a valid passport at all times, unless exempt from passport requirements.
- I will not add or drop classes without first consulting both an Academic Advisor and the International Student Advisor.
- I understand that I am NOT eligible for the Florida resident tuition rate and will be billed the non-Florida resident tuition rate. I understand that I am NOT eligible for federal or state financial aid. (F-1 students may still apply for privately funded scholarships or other forms of aids).
- I understand that I am NOT allowed to work off campus in the United States without ICE authorization. I may; however, work on campus for a maximum of twenty hours per week when school is in session.
- I must notify the International Student Advisor at least a minimum of 2 weeks prior to traveling outside the U.S. so that my current I-20 form can be endorsed for travel or a new form can be issued.
